Dear Parents and Carers,

Next week, your child will have come home with their Semester 1 report.

I ask that all parents take the time to read and understand their child's report as it contains valuable information about their achievement and progress in first semester. Vital explanatory notes to assist you in making sense of your child's report are also provided on the reverse of the report's cover page.

As our expectations of students at each year of school has increased under the West Australian Curriculum, it is possible that your child's 'grades' may appear to have declined in comparison to recent years. This does not exactly mean that they have not progressed; rather it is most likely that our expectations of them have lifted. It is important at this stage to clarify that 'A' and 'B' grades are only issued when a student is consistently performing at a level that exceeds the expected standard for their year level – these grades are awarded far less than when you and I went to school.

I am confident that the information provided by your child's teacher/s in this report is a valid and reliable summary of their achievement, attitude, behaviour and effort throughout the first two terms of 2023.

I would strongly recommend that if you are concerned about any aspect of your child's report that you make an appointment with the classroom teacher after the holidays. If you are still concerned after this, please feel free to discuss any concerns further with me.
